CHURCH ROOFING UPDATE. Ministry Board has given the Board of Stewards the go-ahead to replace the roofing on the north end of the church with the shingling option they recommended after getting quotes that included a metal roofing option. The cost of \$27-30,000 will be covered by welcome reserves from the 2017 budget year, so no additional funds will be needed. This should give our entire roof a life-span of 20-25 years. We have endorsed the roof replacement to proceed as soon as possible as timing is important for booking the contractor and for addressing concerns with missing shingles and leaks in the upper level washrooms. -- *Ministry Board*
